THE SALVATION EQUATION (Luke 24:47)

$$\text{Repentance (Mankind's Part)} + \text{Forgiveness of Sin (God's Part)} = \text{Eternal Life}$$

The word "repentance" was translated from the Greek word "metanoë" meaning: to CHANGE any or all of the elements composing one's life: attitude, thoughts, and behaviors concerning the demands of God for right living. Subsequently, to "repent" means to "obey God's 10 Love Commandments". And these 'works of love' are the proof of one's FAITH in God (Galatians 5:6) since "faith without works is dead" (James 2:14-26).

The Apostle Paul's Beautiful Description of Love

"Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing... Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things... Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when that which is perfect has come, that which is in part will be done away. For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face... And now abide faith, hope, love, these three, but the greatest of these is love."
